LIVING OUR MISSION - Bringing our Mission to life through education, reflection and action

Breast Cancer Education (SAE) - Assists individuals who have been diagnosed with breast cancer and are undergoing treatment by providing materials, supplies, resources and education to help them make informed decisions.

Cancer Care Closet (SJB) - Provides wigs, hats, scarves and other head coverings for those managing the effects of cancer treatment.

Clare's Closet (SAE) - When a traumatic event brings a patient through the ER, their clothing is frequently ruined. Your gift to Clare's Closet purchases clothing, underwear, coats, diapers, car seats and more to help patients return home with dignity and relief.

Community Garden (GSS) - The community garden is a collaboration with other organizations to grow, harvest and distribute healthy food throughout our community.

Community Health Equity (System) - These initiatives support our Mission to address health disparities for vulnerable populations. We build regional resilience through coordinated programs that span life stages — from prenatal care to college and career readiness — promoting economic stability and health for people of all ages.

Community Sudden Cardiac Arrest/AED Program (PCC) - Actively educating community members in our region on the prevention, signs and response to sudden cardiac arrest, as well as placing life-saving AED machines in highly populated areas.

The Friends Van (SJB, SJH) - An essential community resource providing free transportation to medical, dental and personal appointments for the greater Highland and Breese communities.

Hospital Sisters Mission Outreach (System) - We dream of a world where all people — near and far — have access to quality health care. Helping people across the globe, Mission Outreach partners with organizations, hospitals and clinics through the responsible donation of medical supplies, equipment and support services. This work builds capacity for low-resource health systems, creates economic opportunities and protects the environment.

Ministry Continuation (System) - The history of the Hospital Sisters of St. Francis is fundamental to HSHS' purpose and Mission. HSHS Colleagues ensure this Mission is robust and expansive to all served. This fund promotes a deeper understanding of this heritage while elevating strategic work related to Franciscan, Catholic or other Mission occasions such as the Springfield Pilgrimage.

Pastoral Care (All Ministries) - In the tradition of St. Francis, providing hope, spiritual resources and pastoral/spiritual care to all. Services are wide-ranging and include prayer and sacramental ministry, spiritual and emotional support, assistance contacting a patient's faith leader, ethics consultations, assistance with advance directives and more, whenever there is a need.

St. Clare Center Food Pantry (SFL) - Provides food and supplies to residents of Montgomery and Macoupin counties.

Campus Renovations (SMD) – We are reimagining health care for the future in Decatur. Cutting-edge technology will be centered in four new surgical suites, elevating patient care. This investment is focused on exceptional patient care for decades to come.

Cancer Center (SMG) – Enhances cancer care services by supporting advanced technology, patient support programs, and innovations that improve outcomes and comfort.

Cancer Patients (SFL) – Continue to support those in need of cancer care services close to home in our newly expanded Cancer Care Center.

Cardiac Rehabilitation (GSS, SJS) – Helping patients be stronger for their loved ones; this fund provides commercial-grade equipment, patient and colleague education and items needed for a successful transition to healthy living at home.

Cardio Services (SVG) – Advances cardiovascular care by supporting specialized equipment, technology, and patient care initiatives within the cardiac program.

Center for Pediatric Therapy (SAE) – This new center offers cutting-edge treatment services that cater specifically to the unique needs of children, providing a child-friendly environment designed to promote development, improve mobility and encourage independence without the need to travel to obtain this level of care.

Child Life (SJS) – Our smallest patients deserve big expressions of joy. The child life team teaches coping skills and eases discomfort during hospital stays through play, preparation, education and self-expression.

Children's Hospital (SJS, SVG) – Established to help our most vulnerable patients who are facing frightening procedures in an unfamiliar atmosphere. This fund addresses any needs that exist, including the purchase of medical equipment, upgrades to patient rooms and taking care of families while they have a child in the hospital.

Emergency Department (SNS) – Supports improvements and equipment needed in the emergency department.

Everlasting Memories Program (Hospice, Illinois) – Granting final wishes to our patients in the hospice program, providing them and their families with a special event or experience to create lasting memories.

Family Birth Center (SFL) – Update our labor and delivery and postpartum rooms to provide high quality care for mothers and babies.

Healing Garden (SJS) – The new St. John's Healing Garden will be a front-and-center sanctuary, offering a peaceful space for prayer, reflection and strength during a patient's stay. Designed with calming greenery and quiet seating, it will provide comfort for patients and families while also serving as a welcoming outdoor space for colleagues to recharge and connect.

Medical Equipment and Innovative Technology (GSS, SJB, SAE, HFG, SEO, SJH) – The best professionals need the best tools to ensure excellent outcomes. From the latest medical advancements to important enhancements, this fund empowers our colleagues to reach a higher level of care.

Nursing Excellence (SNS) – Supports nursing initiatives that advance clinical excellence, professional development and high-quality patient care.

Nursing and Health Care Workforce Wellness Fund (SMG) – Invests in the recruitment, education, retention and professional development of nurses and health care team members to strengthen the future of patient care.

Pastoral Care (SCO) – Supports spiritual care services for patients, families, and colleagues, ensuring compassionate emotional and faith-based support during times of need.

Prairie: Prairie Education and Research Cooperative (PERC) – Strengthen physician-led research and clinical research trials, so our patients continue to have access to the most advanced treatments before the rest of the nation. Providing continued medical education (CME) opportunities to ensure our health care professionals are well educated, qualified and kept abreast of advanced treatments and technologies to care for their patients.

Safe Sleep (SJS) – Provides families with essential education and resources to ensure a safe sleeping environment for infants. The program distributes safe sleep supplies, such as cribs, bassinets, and sleep sacks, along with informative materials on safe sleep practices. By partnering with local organizations and health care providers, the initiative aims to reduce sleep-related incidents and ensure families receive the support needed to prioritize their child's safety during sleep.

Scholarship Program (SCO) – Provides educational scholarships that support the growth and development of future health care professionals and current colleagues pursuing advanced training.

Share Pregnancy and Infant Loss Support (SNS, SVG) – Provides support to families experiencing the tragic loss of their baby through pregnancy loss, stillbirth or in the first few months of life. We offer compassion through memorial events for families, lasting mementos like professional photos and bereavement training for colleagues to better minister to their patients.

St. John's College of Nursing (System) – To best prepare the next generation of nurses, this fund enhances facilities and classroom technology for teaching and learning and provides student scholarships for those who qualify.

Unified Strategic Opportunities Fund (System) – With a focus on innovation, this fund provides catalyst investments for system-wide strategic priorities with a priority placed on new technology that advances care from clinical settings to home.
